2. The wine represents the blood of Jesus which does the following for us.

- 1. Jesus had to shed His blood to buy us back Heb 9:22
- 2. The blood justifies (Just as if I had never sinned) us Rom 5:9
- 3. The blood saves us -1 Pet 1:18+19
- 4. The blood allows us to be forgiven of our sin Eph 1:7

3. The bread represents Jesus' body that was broken for us for the following reason:

1. Jesus' body was broken for our healing – Is 53:5, 1Pet 2: 24

- 1. Examine yourself 1Cor 11:28
- 2. Judge yourself and not others 1Cor 11:31, Mt 7:1-5
