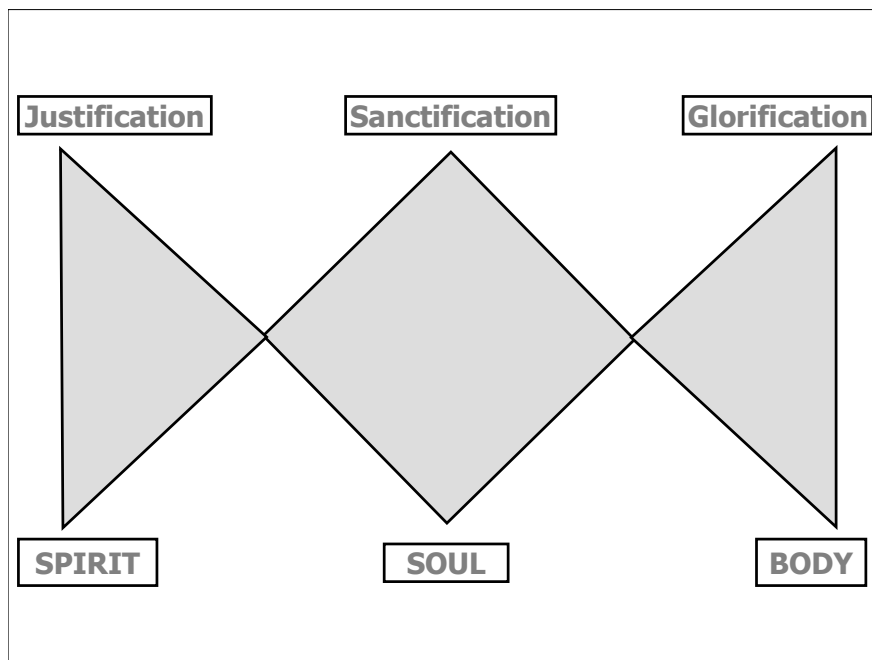




JUSTIFICATION, SANCTIFICATION AND GLORIFICATION



1. Justification

- Def. Just as if I had never sinned
- Not even the Old Testament saints were justified by works – Rom 4:2
- We are only justified by faith – Rom 5:1
- We are justified through Christ's blood – Rom 5:9
- We cannot be justified by keeping the law – Gal 3:11
- The law helped us get to Christ who justifies us – Gal 3:24-25

2. Sanctification

- Def. The daily process of becoming holy
- We sanctify ourselves by applying the word – Jhn 17:17
- We must die daily – 1 Cor 15:31
- We must pick up our cross daily (crucify yourself) – Lk 9:23
- We do this by renewing our minds to think according to the word – Rom 12:2
- We must apply what we learn to be blessed – Jms 1:23-25

3. **Glorification**

- God will give us a new body – 1 Cor 15:42
- We will get a Spiritual body – 1 Cor 15:44
- Jesus had a Spiritual body – Jhn 20:26
- Elijah and Moses have their spiritual bodies – Mt 17:3
- Old Testament saints have their spiritual bodies – Mt 27:52-53
