1. Definition

- Means to smear and rub into
- God comes and rubs His supernatural ability into our natural ability and thus supernatural things can happen through us
- Christ means anointed and messiah (it is not a title but a function)
- We get our anointing when we are in Christ

- Hope – 1 Cor 15:19
- Leads us in triumph – 2 Cor 2:14
- Veil taken away - 2 Cor 3:14
- New creation – 2 Cor 5:17
- Justified by faith – Gal 2:16
- Blessings of Abraham – Gal 3:14
- Sons of God – Gal 3:26
- Every spiritual blessing – Eph 1:3
- Seated in heaven – Eph 2:6
- Perfection – Col 1:28

3. How to operate in the anointing

- Abide in Christ – Jhn 15:4
- The anointing now abides in you – 1 Jhn 2:27
- The more we meditate on His word, pray, fast, worship, seek after Him the stronger the anointing in our lives become
- The less we abide the less the supernatural power flows

4. **We need the anointing**

- Only it breaks the yolk of bondage – Is 10:27
- When someone prays for you and releases the anointing what they are really doing is releasing the supernatural power that they carry over your life to fulfill the miracle that you need like Peter in Acts 3:6.
- The anointing is not for a few but for all those who desire it and are prepared to pay the price to carry it in their own lives
