1. **Definition**

- Living:
- to live, to breathe, to be among the living (not lifeless, not dead)
- to enjoy real life:
- to have true life that is worthy of the name
- to be active, blessed, and endless in the kingdom of God
- to live, that is, to pass life, in the manner of the living and acting
- of mortals or character
- living water, having vital power in itself and exerting the same upon the soul
- metaphorically, to be in full vigor
- to be fresh, strong, efficient,
- as adjective: active, powerful, efficacious

2. **Water of life**

- Comes from God's house – Ez 47:1
- Unaffected by time or season – Zec 14:8
- Christ is the source- Jhn 4:10
- Satisfies the deepest needs – Jhn 7:37-38
- The supply inexhaustible – Rev 7:17
- Makes life fruitful – Rev 22:1-2
- Universal call to partake of – Rev 22:17
- Local in its refreshing – Is 12:3
- Inward well of spiritual experience – Jhn 4:14
- Inward well become a flowing river of blessing (After the baptism of the Holy Spirit) – Jhn 7:38
- This river gives life wherever it flows –Ez 47:9

3. **We need this water to cleans us daily**

- Clean the inside - Matt. 23:25-28,33
- The Lord's Supper - 1 Cor. 11:29-30
- Clean your mind - Rom. 12:1-2; Js 1:13-15
