1. **Definition**

- The word shekinah does not appear in the Bible, but the concept clearly does.
- The Jewish rabbis coined this extra-biblical expression, a form of a Hebrew word that literally means "he caused to dwell,
- " signifying that it was a divine visitation of the presence or dwelling of JEHOVAH God on this earth.
