2. Prayer of Consecration

 The prayer of dedication, or to be set apart by God for His purposes – Acts 13:2, Lk 22:42

3. Prayer of Commitment

 The prayer of committing a person, event or circumstance to God; the act of laying that person, event or circumstance aside as a burden that must be released. – 1 Pt 5:7

4. Prayer of Worship

The Psalms are full of prayers of worship extolling God.

5. Prayer in Agreement

 Get another human to agree with you with you pray to release power – Mt 18:19-20

6. Prayer in the Spirit

This build up the power inside you and also prays through you for you –
1 Cor 14:2, 15

7. United Prayer

Pray with believers in one accord – Acts 4:31

8. Intercessory Prayer

Where you pray on behalf of someone else – Rom 8:34
