1. **Definition**

Greek – "Poimen" – a shepherd

2. Qualification of a Pastor

A. Must have the character qualifications of an elder – 1Tim 3, Titus 3

3. Ministry of a Pastor

- A. Sheep will recognise his voice Jhn 10:3
- B. Will be sensitive to the sheep (sit where they sit) Ez3:15
- C. Will call his sheep by name Jhn 10:3
- D. Will go ahead and lead the sheep and they will trust him 1 Cor 11:1
- E. Will lead the sheep into fresh pastures in the Word Jhn 10:3
- F. Will love and have compassion for the sheep Mk 6:34
- G. Will be willing to lay down his life Jhn 10:11
- H. Will stay with the sheep when the wolf comes Jhn 10:12
- I. Will constantly care for the sheep Jhn 10:13
- J. Will always be the alert for other sheep Jhn 10:16
- K. Will recognise the unity of the flock (one flock) Jhn 10:16
- L. Will recognise that he is an under shepherd to Jesus Christ Jhn 10:16
- M. Will discern bleating from murmuring Jhn 10:27
- N. Will minister healing to the flock James 5:14
- O. Will not Lord it over the flock Acts 20:17
- P. Will exercise government ministry Mt 2:6
- Q. Will not drive but lead the sheep Gen 33:13, Is 40:11
- R. Will carry the lambs Lk 15:4-5
- S. Will use the measuring rod in love on his sheep 1 Cor 4:21
