- Lucifer / Satan / Devil Fallen archangel Rev 12:9
- False prophet Rev 16:13
- The anti-Christ / Beast Rev 13:2

### 3. Principalities

• Chief rulers or highest order – Eph 6:12

#### 4. Powers

 Sergeants (Authorities that carry out the orders of the principalities) – Eph 6:12

# 5. Rulers of this age

- Natural men and rulers under demonic control Eph 6:12
- They would not have crucified Christ had they known 1 Cor 2:8

#### 6. Wickedness in heavenly places

Demons who are wicked and operate all around the earth – Eph 6:12

### 7. Fallen angels

- Satan took a third of the angels Rev 12:4,7,9
- All angels have bodies Neh 9:6
- They hold the ranks of principalities and powers Rom 8:38
- They learn about God's plan through watching the church Eph 3:10
- Jesus totally disarmed them at His death for the church Col 2:15

#### 8. **Demons**

- Demons don't have bodies
- They are the result where the fallen angels had sex with women in Gen 6·2-4
- These angels were punished and are bound awaiting judgement Jd 1:6
- The spirits of these children were not human spirits but half demonic and these spirits are what we call demons and are always looking for a body to inhabit.
- They hold the rank of wickedness in heavenly places.
- They roam continually in the atmosphere looking for a right to inhabit a body – Eph 4:27
- They are territorial Mrk 5:9-12
- Jesus commands believers to cast demons out Mk 16:17

#### 9. 5 ranks of the demonic are:

a. Demonic trinity - Satan, the antichrist, the false prophet

b. Principalities - Fallen angelsc. Powers - Fallen angels

d. Rulers of this age - Human beings under demonic control

e. Wickedness in heavenly places - Demons
