


DELIVERANCE PART 1

1. What is Deliverance?

- Deliverance is not a ministry
- It is for all believers Mark 16: 17
- It brings someone into liberty after they have been bound in an area for whatever reason.
- There is not such a thing as identifying each demon that is attacking.
 Jesus never did this.

2. Demon possession vs. demonisation

- The term demon possession implies that you do not have a choice
- Everyone has a choice to get set free. Mk 5:6-12
- There are only levels of demonisation



3. <u>Is deliverance necessary?</u>

- No, inner healing and deliverance would not be necessary if you released all at salvation;
- Unfortunately, we have need of both inner healing and deliverance, because we carry excess baggage.

5. Can a Christian have a demon?


Yes, the following diagram explains why:

6. Why is it that a Christians can be under the anointing for years and all of a sudden they manifest a demon?

- A demon only manifests (exposes) itself when it is threatened.
- You are like a house with many rooms.



- A demon only manifests (exposes) itself when it is threatened.

- It is just like the Israelites possessing the land. They had one battle at a time but eventually they possessed it.
