



# **DELIVERANCE PART 2**

## 1. How do you do deliverance?

- There are 2 types of Deliverances:
  - A person coming for counseling;
  - A person manifesting under the anointing.

## 2. A person coming for demonic counseling

- There are 3 phases called 45-10-45 principle:
  - 45% Pre deliverance counsel;
  - 10% Deliverance;
  - 45% Post deliverance counsel.

#### a. <u>45% Pre-deliverance counsel</u>

- Find the root (the open door).
- 90% of the time the door is unforgiveness.
- Explain what deliverance is about and how to keep the door closed.
- Determine if the person is serious or not.

#### b. 10% Deliverance

- Deliverance is broken into 3 parts:
  - Repentance
  - Forgiveness
  - Renouncing

#### 1. Repentance:

- Recommit the person to the Lord;
- Get the person Born Again.

#### 2. Forgive Others:

• Ask God to help the person forgive and release the person to God for Him to deal with.

- Now you lead the person in a renunciation prayer in which the person renounces all demonic spirits and commands them to loose the person, as they don't have any more right in their lives;
- Once the person has prayed, you lay hands on them and release the anointing and allow the Holy Spirit to fill them to overflowing.

#### c. <u>45% Post –deliverance counsel</u>

- Once the person is sober and out from under the anointing, you start post deliverance counseling.
- This is where you teach the person how to keep the door closed and walk in the victory.
- You must now get the person into home cell and church and you must do the follow-up.

### 3. A person manifesting under the anointing

- You must take the person out of the anointing.
- You must calm the person down and then start with pre-deliverance counseling.

### 4. Do's in Deliverance

- Pray before deliverance if possible.
- Know and apply your weapons.
- Get others to help if necessary.
- Pray for a total release after deliverance of any spirits that might want to latch onto you.

## 5. Don'ts in Deliverance

- Don't pray in tongues in deliverance until post-deliverance stage.
- Don't touch the person until post-deliverance stage.
- Don't bring buckets and other equipment.
- Don't attempt a major deliverance alone.
- Don't take spectators into a deliverance

### 6. <u>Summary</u>

- Know your weapons of warfare.
- We don't have to fast for demons to leave as Jesus has now died and paid the price.
