



## **BE ESTABLISHED**

### 1. **To be established we must:**

- Be cemented in Christ

### 2. **Walk in Him - Col 2:6-7**

1. To “walk in Him” means that we have our roots in Him – Col 2:7
  - a. “Walk in Him” means that we have our roots in Him - Col 2:7.
    - If the root system is damaged in any way, the plant will not survive.
    - The roots are where the plant receives its nutrients.
    - The roots are the most important part of the plant.
  - b. The foundation of our faith must be in Christ
    - No other foundation but Christ – 1 Cor 3:11
    - Christ is the chief cornerstone – Eph 2:19-22
2. To “walk in Him” means that we are “established in the faith” – Col 2:7.
  - a. To be “established in the faith” means that we are strong in our faith.
    - If we have our roots in Christ, we will be established in Him.
    - We have to be strong in our faith.
  - b. To be “established in the faith” also means that we continue to grow in our faith.
    - If we are not growing in our faith, we are not pleasing to Him.
    - Also, if we are not growing in our faith, we will no
3. To “walk in Him” means that we abound in our faith with thanksgiving – Col 2:7.
  - a. When we “walk in Him,” we can be thankful because of the blessings that we have in Him.
  - b. As children of God, we are to always be thankful.
    - Paul tells the Christians in Colosse to be thankful.- Col 1:12, 3:15

- We also read in other places that we are to be thankful – Ps 100:4, 1 Thes 5:18

### 3. **We are called to be established**

- Through the gospel – Rom 16:25
- For every good word and work – 2 Thes 2:17
- To stay in the truth – Heb 13:9

- We are grounded in Christ – Ps 16:8, 55:22, 125:1, Col 1:23
