

1. Definition

- The Book of Life is a record written by God before the creation of the world, listing people who will live forever in the kingdom of heaven. – Rev 17:8
- Also known as the Lambs book of Life

2. The book is mentioned

- Moses knew of the existence of Jehovah's book of life, and realized a person's name could be removed (blotted out) from it. - Ex 32:31-33
- It is important to remain faithful to the one true God. Not doing so could result in one's name being removed from God's book of life. Ps 69:27-28
- All of the dead will be raised for judgment, and some of them will receive everlasting life. Dan 12:1-2
- Those who fear Almighty God Jehovah, calling on His name and serving Him, will be found written in the book of remembrance. Mal 3:16-18
- A person whose name is not in the book of life will serve the beast. Rev 13:4-9
- Jesus mentions that the disciples are in the book Lk 10:20
- Paul mentions his fellow missionary workers are in the book Phil 4:3
- If you obey and serve God you WILL NOT EVER be blotted out Rev 3:5
- Many books are opened, one of them being the Book of Life. The dead are judged according to their works. Those not found written in the Book of Life will be thrown into the lake of fire. Rev 20:11-15
