- The Lord hates lies and lack of integrity. - Zec 8:16-17
- It may be difficult to maintain your integrity. - Job 2:3, 2:9, Prov 29:10
- Your character can be corrupted by bad company. - 1 Cor 15:33
- Integrity will be rewarded. - 1 Kings 9:4-5, Neh 7:2, Ps 41:11-12
