

1. You wake up

- Wake up in your home in the city of New Jerusalem. Each person has a specially designed home just for them - Is. 65:21; Jhn 14:2
- After resting you think about everything you're going to do today. Heb 4:1-11; Rev 14:13
- Outside your home is fruit you planted Isa. 65:21
- You and some of your neighbors eat and have a drink Mt. 8:11; Lk 14:15; 22:29-30; Rev 19:9, Mt. 26:29; Lk 22:18).

2. You leave the city

- You leave New Jerusalem out of one of the 12 gates that are always open - Is 60:11; Rev. 21:24-26)
- The country is full of animals
 - o herds of camels Is. 60:6
 - A leopard lying down with a goat and a cow and a bear eating together. Animals now co-exist peacefully - Is 11:6-9
 - o and do not prey on one another Isa. 65:25
 - You then climb a great mountain Rev. 21:10

3. You would rule a city or 10

- Agriculture will become the basis of society. Small, family-owned farms will produce bountiful harvests without soil erosion or the use of harmful pesticides or chemical fertilizers -Amos 9:13
- Proper farming methods, favorable weather and societal respect for farming will bring joy to the farmers of the future. It's your communication tower – Jer 33:3. Ps 141:1-2
- Business and industry will still exist, but on a far different scale. The emphasis will be on serving others. For example, beating swords into plowshares -ls 2:4
- will involve manufacturing equipment for constructive purposes from war machinery that was once used for destruction.
- Even the source of many raw materials will change. Abundant mineral resources from the oceans will be made available for productive use -ls 60:5
- Cities will be rebuilt, intelligently planned so that people won't experience
 the problems of overcrowding and separation from the beauty and
 tranquility of an agrarian society. Cities will be architecturally
 breathtaking, built according to a divinely inspired master plan Amos
 9:14

- You cannot think of a better way to spend eternity than to be with God, the maker of all things - Ecc. 11:5; Jer. 10:16; Col. 1:15-16
